Explore and experience the uniqueness of each of these distinct areas in your new tropical paradise.

**Sanibel and Captiva Islands** – stroll pristine white sand beaches and master the “Sanibel Stoop” as you tour the best shelling beaches in North America. Explore miles of hiking, biking and wilderness trails that have been preserved as sanctuaries. Plus, experience the pleasures of local dining, shopping and attractions.

**Fort Myers Beach** – the whole family will enjoy one of the safest beaches around since the shoreline gently slopes into the Gulf of Mexico. Enjoy boating, kayaking, parks and recreational areas. And bring your binoculars so you don’t miss spectacular views of the dolphins or any of the other diverse wildlife that share this coastal island.

**City of Fort Myers** – located on the Caloosahatchee Intracoastal Waterway, Fort Myers is known as the “City of Palms” because the main thoroughfare is lined with 1,800 majestic royal palms.
